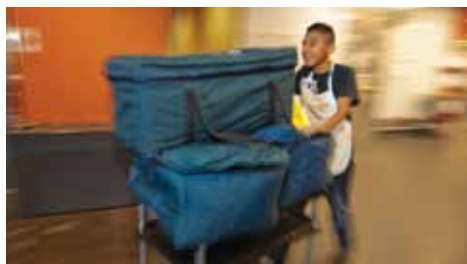



2 MILLION MEALS

FROM YOUR HANDS TO OUR CLIENTS' HOMES

On Friday, June 11, 2010, U.S. Senator Amy Klobuchar helped mark an important milestone for Open Arms and our community by announcing our 2 millionth meal – and delivering it to the home of our client Mary Pat.

In her comments that day, Senator Klobuchar noted that we had cooked and delivered the first million meals over the course of 19 years, yet the second had taken just five years. How did we do that? Through our remarkable donors and volunteers. Over the years, our friends have dedicated their time, resources and talent to helping us ensure that people in our community with life-threatening diseases have delicious, healthy food. They've also supported us in the organizational innovation that has enabled us to continuously enhance our services and grow our client base.

With this milestone coming on the eve of our grand opening here at 2500 Bloomington Avenue, it seemed only natural to look forward to the next million meals and wonder how long it would take us to get there. What new and innovative things could we do, together?

STEPPING UP TO THE NEED



OUR MINNESOTA PROGRAM

As much as we loved the big open spaces, the windows and light of 2500 Bloomington Avenue, the most thrilling aspect of the new building was the kitchen, with its state-of-the-art equipment and expanded walk-in refrigerator and freezer space. That increased capacity for food preparation and storage meant we could expand our services at a critical time, when an ailing economy, an aging population and a record growth in new HIV cases all pointed toward an increased need – one we knew we could do more to meet.

As part of that, we looked at ways to build new and stronger relationships within our community. With a generous grant from the F.R. Bigelow Foundation, we launched an initiative connecting Open Arms with medical and service providers in Ramsey County. The Minnesota Affiliate of Susan G. Komen for the Cure also helped us reach out for breast cancer referrals through the medical community in the Twin Cities. In the process, we created a bevy of new outreach tools, including an e-newsletter that continues to help keep Open Arms in front of providers and increase referrals. Of our 414 new clients in 2010 – a 26 percent increase over 2009 – we saw the greatest increase among people living with cancer.

Our breast cancer clients say Open Arms meals help them get more and healthier calories, so they can stay strong through chemotherapy. Recently, our board president, Lisa Vanderheyden chatted

with her family about what the meals meant to all of them when her sister-in-law was diagnosed with breast cancer. “I was also able to rest and enjoy the good days more, because I wasn’t shopping and cooking for myself and the kids,” said Carolyn, a single mom with five children. “I felt less worried, because I knew the kids had something good to eat. When I’m on chemo, I have to be careful to avoid sick people because my immune system is compromised, so keeping the kids healthy is really important.”

As a caregiver, Lisa said the biggest gift was the peace of mind. “The meals allowed us to focus on the family’s other needs,” she explained. “We could really spend time with the kids and help take their minds off the stress of their mom’s illness. We also didn’t feel that pressure to make sure they were eating better food than they could cook for themselves – you can only eat so many hot dogs.”

Carolyn’s kids spoke warmly of Open Arms kids’ menu, which is also free to children of clients. Nine-year-old Bijou loved the fruit and healthy snacks, while her 6-year-old sister, Asia, liked Open Arms’ nutritious take on chicken-parmesan fingers – and Jill, their delivery volunteer.

Sam, who is 12, said she liked the ease of the meals: “Without these meals, it would be a lot more work for my mom, and we wouldn’t have time do other things with her.”

At 14, Turner said he enjoyed the choice and independence that comes with a

week’s worth of meals. “It’s just good food, and I feel lucky to have this food; it makes a big difference. My favorite is the pulled pork – that stuff’s good!”

In addition to getting more folks into our program, we also looked at what we could do to make our services stronger – and improve our clients’ quality of life. With the support of our donors and volunteers, our chefs redesigned our menus to include fresher, more seasonal dishes and, wherever possible, organic ingredients. We added new menus to meet our clients’ vegetarian, gluten-free and low sodium requirements. On the sweeter side: we took advantage of a brand new, full production bakery and created our own healthy, delicious breads, breakfast pastries and, yes, desserts. *(Read more on page 10.)*

We stepped up our food safety procedures by creating a Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Points plan, a formal program to minimize the risk of foodborne illness to clients, staff and volunteers. In tandem with that effort, we began creating new package labels that include food-handling information, so clients can maintain safety in their kitchens. In that same spirit, we developed a colorful biannual print newsletter that provides service updates, food safety instructions, and goodies such as the recipes for favorite menu items.

And so it was that, by end of year 2010, Open Arms and you, our donors and volunteers, together cooked and delivered more than 365,000 meals – a 16.7 percent

increase over 2009 – serving some 1,406 people living with chronic illnesses and, in many cases, their children and caregivers.

In return, we received some of the best feedback ever in that year’s client survey, garnering a 91 percent satisfaction rating for our meals. As one client said, “I love all of it – the food that is – even better are the people and organizations that make it all happen. Thanx!”

OUR INTERNATIONAL PROGRAM

In 2010, Open Arms and our community continued to support our clients at the J.L. Zwane Centre in Guguletu, South Africa, providing more than 3,200 HIV/AIDS-affected people with 10,904 hot lunches. Through your generous donations, we also sponsored 502 food parcels containing basic staples, such as samp, beans, sugar, tea and maize meal – essentially enough food to feed a family for a month.

They were delivered, in two distributions, to members of the Centre's HIV support group, as well as to a small number of community orphans and child-headed households impacted by HIV/AIDS.

Much like our Minnesota programs, our clients at the Centre report that the hot lunch and food parcel programs strengthen their sense of hope and help them to stay compliant with their treatments, which are often grueling. Hope is important in Guguletu, a community of 350,000 people facing extreme challenges of poverty, hunger and the highest HIV-infection rate in the Western Cape.

As part of a documentary about people living "Life Around the Game," also known as the 2010 World Soccer Cup, a group of Minneapolis soccer fans partnered with the firm Brave New Media to capture our June food parcel distribution. The team created a poignant series of filmed vignettes that document the day, the tremendous need and the voices of Centre leaders, volunteers and clients. In December, another contingent that included Operations Director Kent Linder, Global Programs Director Jane Letourneau and Assistant Food Services Director Asei Tendle coordinated the second parcel delivery. As a team, they volunteered at the Centre, cooking meals and packing the food parcels, and then went out into the community to help paint a local hospice center, visit several HIV/AIDS-related non-profits in the Cape Town area, and learn about innovative HIV/AIDS relief projects.

Not long ago, we partnered with the Minnesota Department of Health, the National Alliance of State and Territorial AIDS Directors (NASTAD), and local health-care leaders in Oromia, Ethiopia, to look at volunteer-based AIDS relief. That collaboration resulted in the Adama Nutritional Support Project, which provides emergency food relief and community support services for people living with HIV/AIDS. In 2010, we revisited Oromia and, though still in its infancy, we found the program going strong. As Ato Shallo Daba, head of the

Oromia Health Bureau, said, "This act of saving lives and reclaiming dignity through the collaboration is extraordinary. Definitely your investment is working."

We also saw an opportunity to invest more and help local leaders improve the health of their community. Our commitment was to provide technical assistance in the areas of fundraising and development, community mobilization and volunteerism, as well as nutrition analysis. This allowed us not only to share what we have learned in 25 years of cooking and delivering meals via our volunteers and donor community, but also to foster the connections between the Open Arms mission, our own garden project and Minneapolis' growing Ethiopian community.

In all, it was a strong year for our international program – which is even more remarkable when we reflect that it still represents just 10 percent of our budget. Thank you: That success is due to the generosity and hard work of our donors and volunteers, here and in Africa.

ADVOCACY

In the Fall Scoop of 2010, we recognized food justice, a growing worldwide movement, as fundamental to our work. Open Arms believes that no matter what your challenges are – illness and poverty included – you should always have access to good, healthy food. And clearly, the tremendous support and dedication of our Twin Cities community shows that you believe so, too.

So, our focus on food justice was not necessarily a new idea, but a thoughtful follow-on to another year of community involvement and connection.

In 2010, our executive director, Kevin Winge, participated in Advocacy Day on the Hill in Washington, D.C., discussing food justice issues and our work with staff members from the offices of Senators Al Franken and Amy Klobuchar and Representatives Keith Ellison and Betty McCullum. At the grand opening ceremony of our new building, Mayor R.T. Rybak announced that he and St. Paul Mayor Chris Coleman had declared June 12 "Open Arms Day" in the Twin Cities, honoring our growing role in the community.

Later in the year, Kevin and our Global Programs Director, Jane Letourneau, along with volunteer, Tony Zappa, visited the Adama Nutritional Support Project in Ethiopia. While there, they became determined to invest technical and nutrition support in the successful program and its clients. The goals mirrored those of our core program: to help prevent starvation, reduce malnutrition and improve nutrition for people living with HIV/AIDS – and, further, to allow people to live and die with dignity. "Funding the garden at the Dawn of Hope rehabilitation center allows our Adama clients to receive important nutrients, which helps improve their health," explains Jane, "but it also gives former clients the opportunity to work in the gardens, give back to the community that helped them regain their health and, in doing so, regain their independence, too."

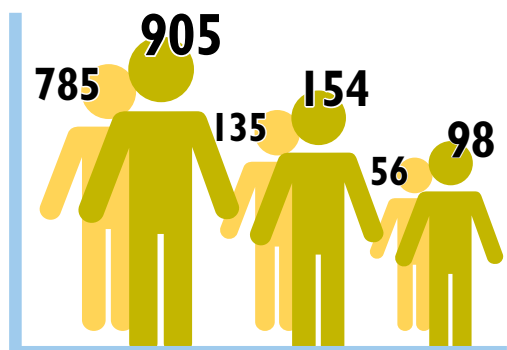

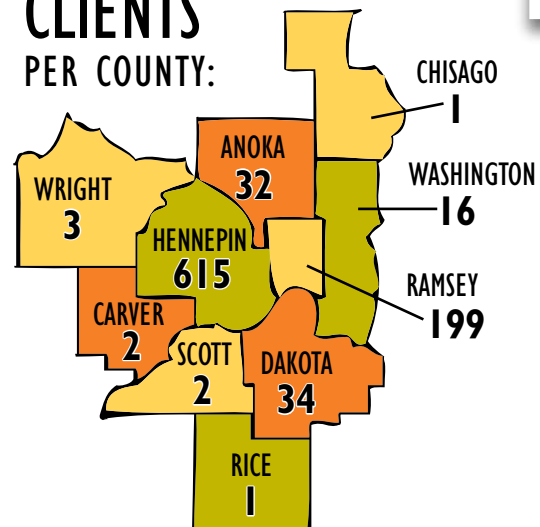

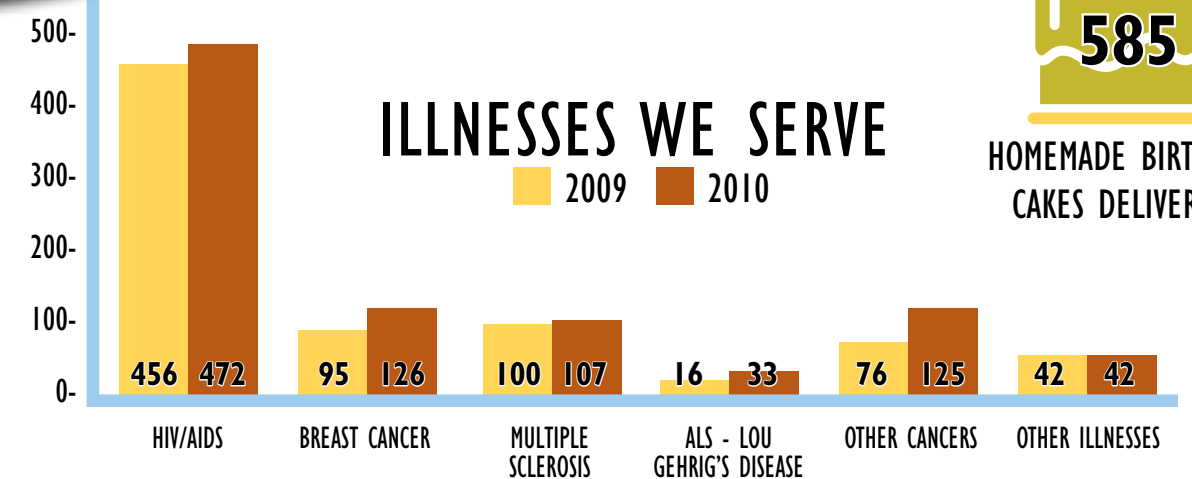
1. We helped our clients celebrate Thanksgiving with 280 organic turkeys and 290 fresh, homemade holiday meals.

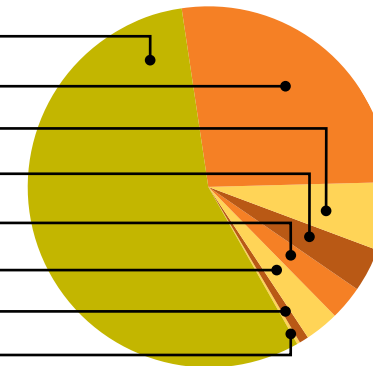

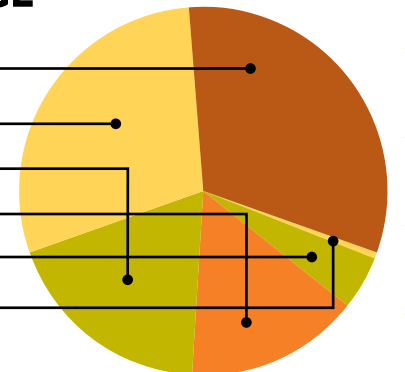

Our partnership with NASTAD also helps raise awareness of and build a stronger relationship with the Ethiopian population here in Minnesota.

Similar in its effort to raise awareness, Kevin launched a campaign to focus attention on Minnesota's food assistance recipients over the holidays, our most abundant food season. During the "SNAP Challenge," Kevin and the other folks who participated shopped, cooked and ate as though they received Minnesota's SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) food stamp program, spending only \$3.95 per person on food each day. Though only a week long, the SNAP Challenge was very successful in raising not only local and national awareness — via a wide-ranging media response — but also personal awareness, generating thought-provoking and often emotional posts on the Open Arms blog and wonderful conversations throughout the week.

In that same month, Greatnonprofits.org ranked us a Top-Rated Food & Shelter Nonprofit based on online

reviews from our volunteers — high praise indeed. “It doesn't matter what shape I'm in when I walk into the building. I always leave Open Arms happy and energized,” one volunteer wrote. “The work of preparing and delivering food is easy to understand; but it is surprisingly transformative for me and other volunteers, for clients, and for the community we live in. Open Arms is a chance to spend a few hours a week acting mindfully and with specific intent to help real people. The fact that this service returns so much benefit to me is nothing short of a miracle.”

She also noted that, true to the commitment above, we provided good food: “Open Arms makes the best use of resources I've ever seen. The amount and quality of food that leaves the kitchen is the living proof.”

OUR VOLUNTEERS

2010 was our first year in our new bakery. If you've never visited it, imagine this: sunlight streaming through floor to ceiling windows and air heavy with the yeasty, sweet smell of bread as racks of golden honey-wheat baguettes roll out of the ovens. These baguettes are baked fresh to be delivered with the day's meals, but the dough is made and frozen a week ahead of time by volunteers including Debby Vanderheyden, Lindsay Pohlad and Marsha Burgeson.

“Don't tell them how sunny it is,” laughed Marsha, one recent morning. “We don't want to build up the bakery too much because we don't want them to take our shifts!”

Including our Friday baking team, Open Arms met 850 new volunteers in 2010. When you look at how many shifts our new and ongoing volunteers worked last year — totaling more than 36,000 hours — it equals roughly the equivalent of 17.5 full-time employees. As we've grown, we've continuously looked for new ways for our extraordinary volunteers to connect with one another, to new ideas and good food, and to the community, even as we all work together to help our clients meet their nutrition needs and get healthy. In part, that means feeding all of us with new opportunities.

Last year, with the help of our volunteers, we started enriching the soil at Open Farms with manure, getting it ready for the next growing season. Located in Belle Plaine at the Prairie Oaks Institute, the two-acre garden was created with the hope that it would be an opportunity for

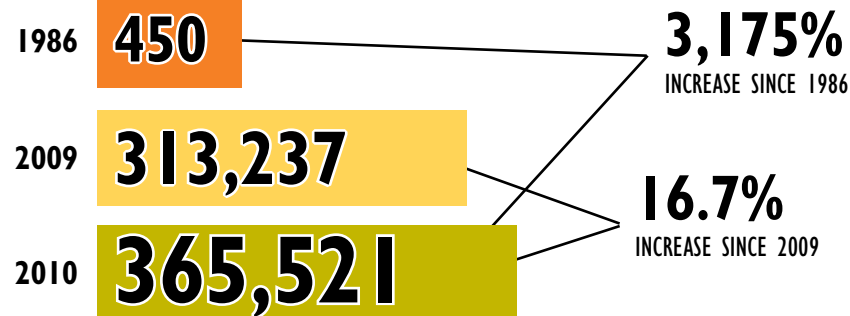

our community not only to grow beautiful, organic vegetables and herbs for our clients’ meals, but also to connect with the land and learn about organic, sustainable, local agriculture. It also introduced a new way for families, faith communities and other groups to work with Open Arms – outdoors, in the sunshine and dirt – on weekdays or weekends.

Thanks to folks like you, our brand new, full-production bakery also presented a key opportunity; it created another way for volunteers to work in the kitchen and learn new skills, and let us live up to our standard of “dessert for everyone,” while also improving the quality of our breads.

We saw new skills in action when we visited with Marsha and her fellow volunteers. As they pulled bread from the mixer, weighed it, scored it and tossed it onto the Bloemhof sheeter – an extraordinary gadget that rolls perfect baguettes – they chatted about what they’ve been eating, what their kids are up to and weekend plans. One would think they’d been baking together forever. Not so, said Lindsay: “We all started in October. We met on the shift and life has been better ever since!”

When we ask the ladies what they enjoyed about their bakery days, they broke into a chorus of answers. Debby, the trained chef of the trio, said she liked the hands-on aspect of baking. “It’s a good way to use my culinary skills,” she said, “and the light in here is great – in the winter it was so nice.”

“It’s fun to do something that’s very different from my normal week,” said Lindsay, “and it’s something that’s for me – you know, I get a babysitter for my son – but it’s also not for me.”

“You’re giving back, but it’s fun and you know you’re providing food for people who are going through a difficult time,” said Debby.

“It’s a great experience,” added Marsha.

OUR DONORS

As we walk around Open Arms, we often find ourselves stopping to read the cheerful donor tiles that line the walls. Each of them is inscribed with a message or a name – sometimes two – and we have found that behind each tile is a story. Sometimes it’s how a person found Open Arms; sometimes it’s how a person, a family or a community lost a loved one. Sometimes, a tile simply recalls the smile of a friend. These tiles also represent personal generosity: In purchasing some 442 tiles, our donors have invested more than \$624,000 in Open Arms. This is just one of the many ways in which our extraordinary community of donors supported us in 2010, ensuring that we continue to thrive and do our work with inspiration, a combination of energy and innovation that would not be possible without our donors’ dedication and love.

In the five years since we determined, as a community, to open our arms a little wider and help clients with HIV/AIDS, ALS, MS, breast cancer and other cancers, the latter

two have shown the greatest growth – a combined 210 new referrals in 2010. Our donors were right there with us as we worked to meet that need.

Of course, sometimes our work feels more like play. At the 6th Annual Moveable Feast, 433 guests embraced a vintage circus theme with joy and generosity, helping us raise \$210,000 for our programs through an online auction, a silent auction and mystery boxes. At the event, we also raffled off a brand new, beautiful Toyota Prius. Thanks in part to a generous grant from the Walser Foundation, the raffle contributed \$43,000 in funds raised, but at \$50 a ticket, also allowed people in our community to participate in the biggest event of our year, even if they could not attend.

2010 marked our third – and most successful! – year as a beneficiary of the The Hartford & RE/MAX Results Breast Cancer Ride. Bicycling across 125 miles of scenic southern Minnesota, the riders raised more than \$65,000 for nutritious, homemade Open Arms meals benefitting people undergoing treatment for breast cancer. We were able to make those meals, officially our “pink meals,” organic due to generous underwriting from the Minnesota Affiliate of Susan G. Komen for the Cure and the Hope Chest for Breast Cancer Foundation. On a similar note, our good friend M•A•C Cosmetics helped us integrate more locally sourced, organic food into the HIV/AIDS menu – and also to expand the number of meals we were able to provide – through a donation from the M•A•C AIDS Fund.

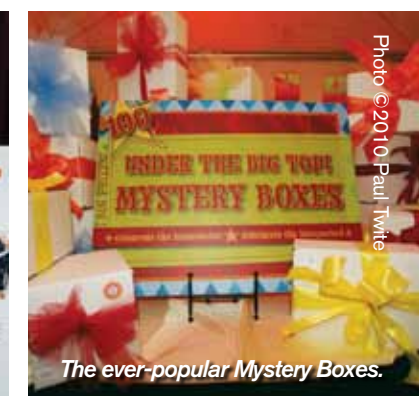

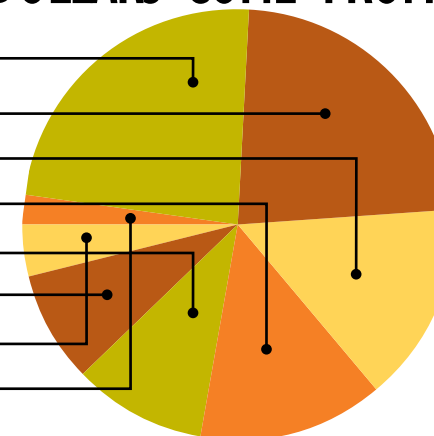

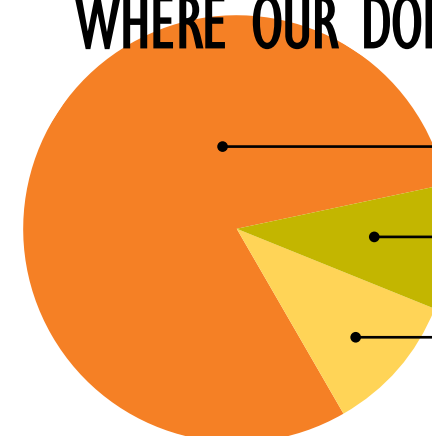
